Have a look at this structure, which uses black and white balls to visualize digital signal movement on the Internet.

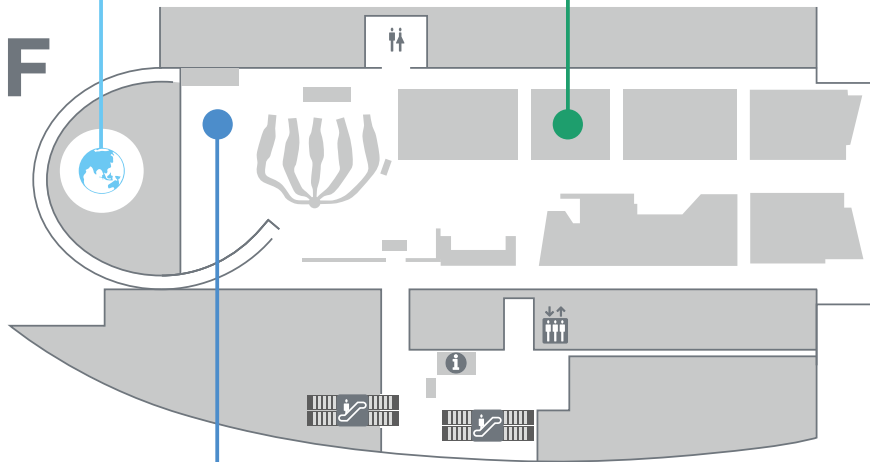


## Laboratory to Explore the Frontiers

\*Please call staff if you cannot touch the robot.



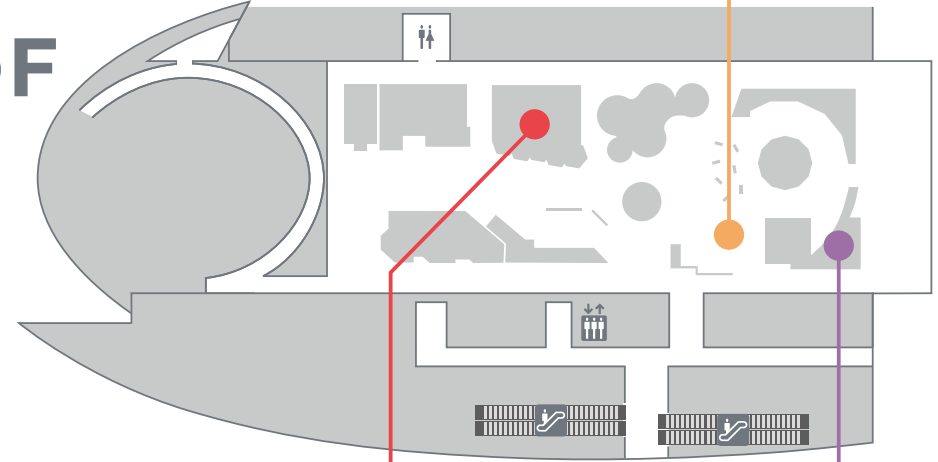
## ASIMO Demonstration
