See space food and a toilet for people living 400km above the Earth, and try to imagine life in space.

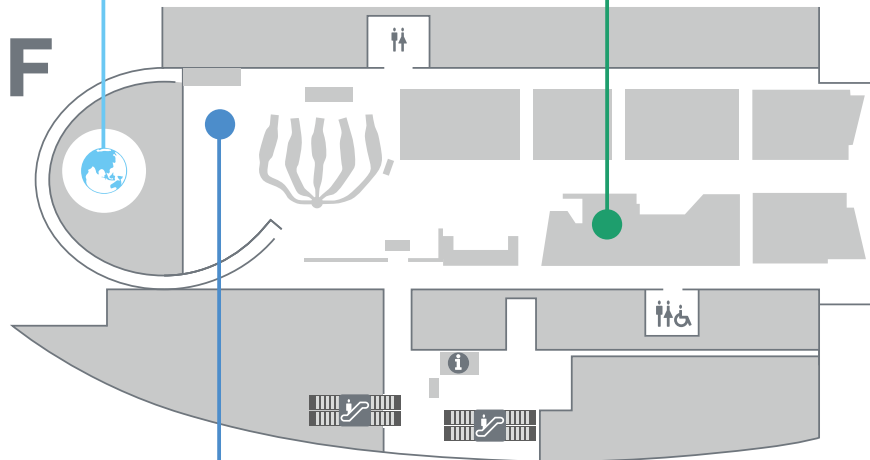


CELLS in Progress

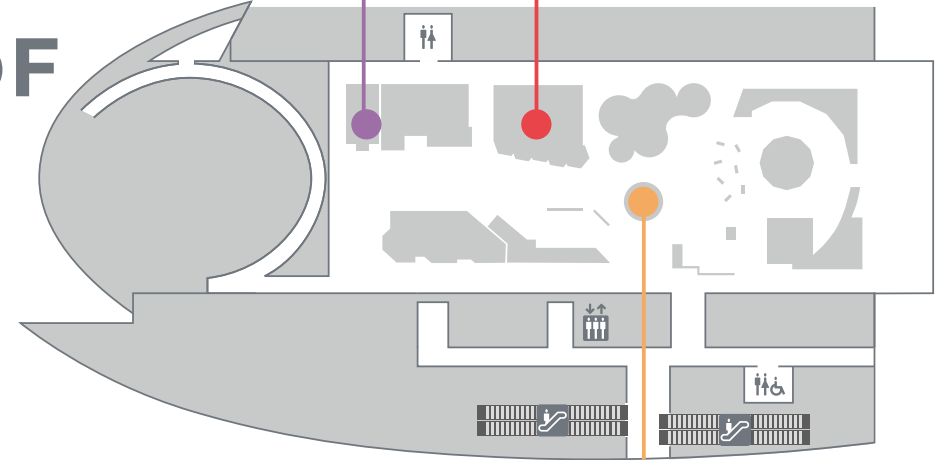
This exhibit is about the development of stem cell research. You can enter any of the five theaters in a wheelchair.
